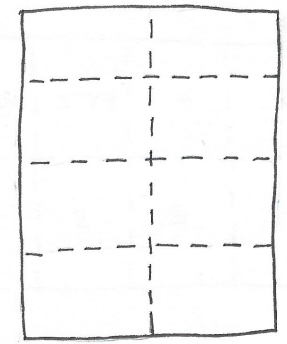
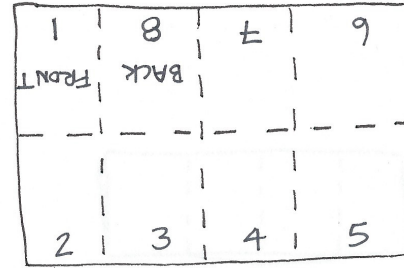


Fold a sheet of paper into eight sections by folding it first lengthways and then twice widthways. Open up the paper and there will be eight areas. These are your pages!



(half right side up, half upside down)



Pencil in the page numbers so you know which section corresponds to which page

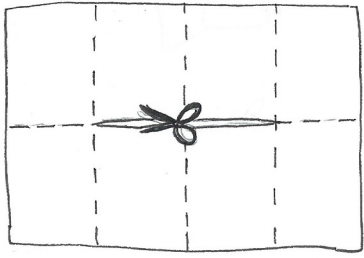
Now you can start making your zine!

Fill each section, and remember to include a front and back page. Some ideas to get you started!

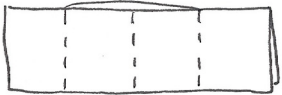
- description and map of places you like to take visitors to

Have fun! Be creative!

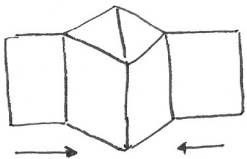
When you're finishing writing or drawing, cut along the fold between 3-4 and 7-8



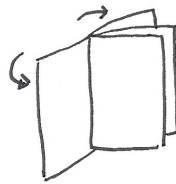
cut section is here

Then push the sides into the middle so it opens up



Then fold the front and back pages around to create the covers and you will have your 8-page zine!
